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**SEVENTEETH AMENDMENT TO THE MASTER DEED AND DECLARATION FOR CREEKWOOD
CONDOMINIUMS**

This 17th Amendment (the "Amendment") to the Master Deed and Declaration of Creek Condominiums is made at the direction of the Creekwood Terrace Condominium Homeowners' Association, Inc. ("Association"), a Kentucky non-profit, non-stock corporation, whose mailing address for all purposes related to this Amendment is 8003 Lyndon Centre Way, Suite 101, Louisville, Kentucky 40222, as an amendment to the Master Deed and Declaration for Creekwood Condominiums (the "Master Deed"), dated the 9th day of May 2002 and filed of record in Deed Book 7885, Page 922 in the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky, as amended:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Association believes the Master Deed, needs to be amended and this Amendment is necessary and desirable to change certain aspects of the Master Deed;

WHEREAS, the Association, having obtained approval of 67% of the total allocated votes of the Association, these owners having been acknowledged and having signed this Amendment, their signatures below as **Exhibit 1**; and there being no eligible mortgage holders having provided notice to the Association; and having complied with the provisions of Article W, as amended by that 5th Amendment to the Master Deed and Declaration, dated the 24th day of July 2002 and of record in the Office of Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky in Deed Book 7928, Page 48:

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the foregoing preambles, which are hereby incorporated herein, the Association hereby declares that the Master Deed is hereby amended as follows and that all such property shall be owned, held, used, leased, conveyed, and occupied subject to the restrictions and conditions set forth in this Amendment as if these restrictions and conditions were included in and made a part of the Master Deed:

1. Article G, Section 4 is added and reads as follows:
